TCCH's mission is to provide accessible, cost effective, high quality, comprehensive health care to all persons, regardless of their socio-economic circumstances.

Financial Information

If you have health insurance: TCCH accepts most insurance programs including Medicaid, Medicare, and most commercial/private HMO's. Please bring a current copy of your insurance card.

All co-payments and deductibles are due at the time of service. As an FQHC, Medicare deductibles are waived for office visits at TCCH centers. Low income patients may pay the lower of their insurance deductible or the sliding fee discount amount.

If you do not have insurance: Please make an appointment with one of our Health Navigators to see about services you may qualify for, including the TCCH Sliding Fee Discount Program.

Please Note: While TCCH's primary mission is to provide access to quality healthcare, it is not a free-care clinic. TCCH offers a variety of payment options and financial assistance for those who qualify.

TCCH is a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) and PHS Sec. 330 grant represents 19% of our total funding. Sliding fee discounts may be available for patients with limited resources. The remainder of our budget is generated from patient fees.

24-Hour Coverage

TCCH is available to patients 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. If a patient gets sick and needs to speak with a provider when clinical locations are closed, our answering service will assist in contacting the provider on call. If you have an acute or serious health issue, please do not hesitate to seek assistance at a local emergency department.

Thank you for choosing Treasure Coast Community Health (TCCH) as your Patient-Centered Healthcare Home.

A Patient-Centered Healthcare Home is not a building, house, hospital, or home healthcare service. It's an approach to providing complete primary care.

The Patient-Centered Healthcare Home model is designed to promote comprehensive, coordinated care delivered by teams of medical, behavioral health, dental, and vision primary care providers. Patients receive this care regardless of income or insurance coverage. The primary care provider and team coordinate all patient health needs, including management of chronic conditions, visits to specialists, hospital admissions, and check-up and test reminders.

Your Appointment

Arrival Time

For convenience, TCCH offers patients a text and/or email link to complete new patient forms online. Established patients also received a text or email to confirm or update their information before each appointment.

In consideration of all patients, we ask that new and established patients arrive 15 minutes before the scheduled appointment time. New patients who wish to complete new patient forms at a TCCH center should arrive 30 minutes before the scheduled appointment time.

Please Bring

- A valid form of identification.
- A list of current medications, both prescribed and over the counter, vitamins, and any supplements that you are taking.
- Any logs, if asked to keep one. For example: glucose log, recording of your blood pressure log, food log, etc.

Cancellations

Many people in the community need clinical health care services and TCCH is dedicated to meeting those needs.

With that in mind, we kindly insist on a 24-hour notice if a patient needs to cancel or reschedule an appointment.
